SCHOLARSHIPS DEADLINES BETWEEN:

NOVEMBER 30th and DECEMBER 31st, 2021

1) Search Is On Scholarship - \$2,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: November 30, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently attending high school, college, vocational, or any other accredited post-secondary institution.
- B) Be 13 years of age or older and a legal resident of the 50 U.S. or D.C.

2) Dell Scholars Program - \$20,000 - 300 Awards (Deadline: December 1, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be on track to graduate from an accredited high school in the current academic year.
- B) Demonstrate a need for financial assistance.

3) Jameela Jamil x I Weigh Scholarship - \$5,000 – 3 Awards (Deadline: December 2, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be 16 years of age or older and in good academic standing.
- B) Be enrolled in a public, private or parochial high school or home study program in the United States.

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4) Stephen J. Brady Stop Hunger Scholarships - \$5,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: December 5, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled in an accredited educational institution (kindergarten through graduate school) in the US.
- B) Have demonstrated on-going commitment to their community by performing unpaid volunteer services.

5) Science Ambassador Scholarship - \$40,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: December 13, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior or an undergraduate student.
- B) Attend a school in the United States in the Fall of 2022.

6) Burger King Scholars Program - \$50,000 – 10 Awards (Deadline: December 15, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a senior in high school.
- B) Have a cumulative high school grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent.
- C) Plan to enroll full-time, without interruption, for the entire 2022-23 academic year at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school.

7) Senior Planning Social Work and Eldercare Scholarship - \$900 – 5 Awards (Deadline: Dec. 15, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- B) Be a High School Senior or Undergraduate with less than 90 credit hours.

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8) Path to Pro Scholarship Program - \$2,000 – 125 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior, high school graduate or have a GED equivalent.
- B) Plan to enroll, or be enrolled, in an approved trade-related program at an accredited two-year school (technical/vocational school or college) in the United States.

9) CX Scholarship - \$10,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: December 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be 13 years of age or older and a legal resident of the 50 U.S. or D.C.
- B) Be currently attending high school, college, vocational, or any other accredited post-secondary institution.

10) Design Thinking Scholarship - \$500 - 2 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled in a degree-granting program at an accredited two or four-year college or university located in the United States.

11) Certified Nursing Assistant Scholarship - \$1,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: December 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently enrolled, accepted, or applying to be in an accredited CNA program in the United States.
- B) Write an essay explaining why you have decided to become a certified nursing assistant.

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12) Thiel High School Fellowship - \$100,000 - 30 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be under the age of 22.
- B) Be interested in designing and building things.

13) Power of Resilience Scholarship - \$1,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: December 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be in either high school or college (undergraduate or graduate program) and must show good academic standing with a GPA of at least 3.0. The scholarship recipient will have made clear their interest in the power of personal resilience when in crisis.

14) CC Bank's Young Scholars Scholarship - \$2,000 – 5 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a US resident under the age of 30.
- B) Be in good academic standing and carry a minimum of a 3.0 GPA.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a current high school senior, college student, or graduate student who is a legal resident of the United States residing in one of the 50 states or the District of Columbia for the 2022 semester.
