

Member Scholarship Application Packet 2018-2019

Scholarship Overview

In spring 2019, Suwannee Valley Electric Cooperative (SVEC) will award up to ten \$1,000 scholarships to high school seniors from throughout SVEC's service territory.

A committee established by SVEC will review all scholarship applications and recommend scholarship recipients to the SVEC Board of Trustees for approval. Students will be recommended for a scholarship based on their cumulative, unweighted high school GPA, the quality of their extracurricular, church, community, civic, work and/or volunteer activities, two letters of recommendation, and their 250- to 500-word essay on why they want to continue their education and how this scholarship will help them do so.

The SVEC Scholarship Program and the Board of Trustees does not and will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, religion or national origin or on any other basis in either the application process or in the consideration and granting of the scholarships provided by SVEC.

Rules and Conditions

By submitting the application package and the attachments and submissions relating to the application, the applicant and his or her parent/guardian signing the application are certifying that the information submitted is true and correct, and the applicant and his or her parent are agreeing to the scholarship rules and conditions set forth below:

- To be eligible for a scholarship, the student must be graduating in spring 2019 from a public, private or charter high school; or a home school in SVEC's service territory, have a cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of at least 3.50 and plan to attend an accredited post-secondary or vocational educational institution. The student must also be a dependent of an SVEC member, but cannot be a child or grandchild of a current SVEC employee or trustee.
- II. The completed and signed application form (and all attachments thereto) and the essay must be received by SVEC by 5:00 p.m., March 29, 2019. All required items can be e-mailed to communications@svec-coop.com, hand delivered to our office at 11340 100th Street, Live Oak, or mailed to:

- III. If an applicant fails to complete the entire application or fails to submit all the items in the format requested hereunder by the deadline, the application will not be considered for any purposes or under any circumstances with respect to the scholarships per the Board of Trustees.
- IV. The application and release of information forms must be signed by both the student applying for the scholarship and the parent/guardian of the applicant and, if either of such signatures is not on the application or release of information form, the application will be considered incomplete, and not considered in the application process.
- V. The scholarship shall be transmitted to the accredited school selected by the scholarship recipient.

- VI. The scholarship shall be announced and awarded in the spring prior to the recipient's graduation, but is contingent and subject to the scholarship recipient graduating from high school and passing any required graduation exam. The scholarship will be paid by SVEC directly to the educational institution for credit to the student's account at the institution with notification of receipt to be received from the educational institution.
- VII. To qualify for the scholarship, the student must attend an accredited community college, four-year college, technical school or vocational school, beginning no later than the spring 2020 term.
- VIII. For the scholarship funds to be received to the benefit of the scholarship recipient, the student must enroll on a full-time basis at the institution selected, which full-time status must be certified to by the institution. Failure to qualify as a full-time student will result in a rescission of the scholarship with the funds being returned from the institution to SVEC. There are no exceptions to this rule, and except as determined by SVEC on a nondiscriminatory basis, there will be no deferral of enrollment.
 - IX. To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant must be a dependent child of a SVEC member at the time the application is made and through graduation from high school. However, the applicant cannot be a child or grandchild of a current SVEC employee or trustee.
 - X. Scholarships will not be awarded solely based on need, however, SVEC expects additional weight and consideration be given to students with financial hardship.
