- * Students **MUST** be in attendance for all scheduled classes for the entire day of the trip.
- * Permission forms **MUST** be turned in by **Wednesday, April 17th to Ms. Christie Williams in the Media Center.**
- * Once a student has chosen a bus they may not change buses. There are **NO** assigned seats for the buses. First come, first serve! The Grad Bash Sponsor/Chaperones reserve the right to assign seats if needed.
- * **ALL students and their belongings will be searched prior to loading the bus.**
- * **NO** over-the-counter medications will be allowed on the bus or in the park. There are first aid services available at the Health Service locations in the park. Any student requiring prescription medication during the event must have a HCSD Medication/Treatment Authorization Form completed and on file in the Student Health Center by **Wednesday, April 10th**. Any prescription medications must be in the original prescription container and only the dosage needed for the event is allowed. The student's name must be printed on the label and a valid picture ID is required. Students may carry inhalers, Epipens, insulin and other necessary medication with the proper prescription documentation.

- * **NO LIQUIDS** of any kind will be allowed on the bus! Snacks must be sealed in their original packaging. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- * **NO** backpacks will be allowed in the park, must leave them on the bus.
- * Purses/bags cannot be larger than a half sheet of paper (8.5" x 5.5")
- * Students **MUST** adhere to the Dress Code set forth by Universal Orlando's Grad Bash Event Staff as well as the Hamilton County School District Dress Code as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct. **(See Dress Code Sheet)**
- * Students will be given their event ticket, wristband and dining card once they load the bus after supper in Clermont. Students are encouraged to take a picture of the back of their ticket in case they were to lose it they could still gain entrance into the park. If you lose your ticket and do not have a picture of it, you will not be admitted into the park. Students will enter and exit the park at the location printed on their wristband (wristbands are color coded).
- * Student dining cards are valid for one (1) Quick Service combo meal (one entrée platter, one combo extra + one beverage). Participating dining locations will be printed on the Grad Bash Event Guide (Park Map). Dining cards are like cash, do not lose them, they can not be replaced.

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

We want all participants to be comfortable during Grad Bash. This document will provide details on what is acceptable and not acceptable to wear to Grad Bash. Universal Orlando Resort's Security team strictly enforces all dress code regulations for Grad Bash.

School Name/Logo Attire

- Seniors are **NOT** permitted to wear attire with their school's name or logo
 - Chaperones **ARE** allowed to wear school name and logo attire

College/Professional Attire

- College and Professional team names and logos on clothing attire are permitted (i.e. polos, shirts)
- No jerseys of any kind are permitted

What is OK to wear to Grad Bash

Accessories

- Sunglasses, hats, & belts

Bags/Purses

- Any bags and purses must be under the size of 8.5" x 5.5" (half a sheet of paper)

Tops/Shirts

- Casual tops and T-shirts
- No midriff shirts, shirt sleeves must be 3" wide, no halter tops
- Brand name (i.e. Nike, Adidas, Under Armor, etc.) are allowed
- No undershirts as an outer garment
- Jackets are allowed (no school jackets)
 - Please check all undergarments underneath jackets prior to departing high school campus**

Bottoms

- Jeans, leggings, running shorts, shorts, and skirts are permitted
- Excessive holes/ shreds on jeans are not allowed. Leggings cannot be sheer or of see-through material

Dresses

- Dresses and rompers are permitted; must be mid-thigh in length, sleeves must be 3" wide
- Spandex bodysuits will not be permitted

Shoes

- Comfortable shoes, tennis shoes, dress sandals, boots, and flip flops are permitted



Please review the below “Not OK” list and ensure all students come appropriately dressed to Grad Bash

What is NOT OK to wear or bring to Grad Bash

- Clothing that exposes excessive portions of skin that may be viewed as inappropriate
- Tank tops, undershirts, sleeveless tops (less than 3 inches in straps)
- Clothing with obscene, offensive language or graphics
- Area codes displayed on clothing
- Clothing with excessive holes or shredding
- Clothes that are too tight or revealing such as spandex bodysuits
- Visible undergarments
- Tops that show midriff or cleavage
- Short shorts showing too much skin or shredded too high.
- Dress, skirt, and romper hemlines must be no shorter than mid thigh
- Pants/shorts falling below the waist
- Accessories such as chains, spiked collars, studded/spiked belts, or accessories that include sharp objects
- High school team name, logo, or mascot
- Jerseys of any kind (including college and professional)
- Large backpacks or purses larger than 8.5” x 5.5”
- Matching or like attire
- No glass containers i.e. perfume, cologne, body spray
- No open water bottles

Requirements for student participation:

*Must be a member of the 12th grade class at Hamilton County High School (as indicated by Skyward) by Friday, February 2nd, 2024.

*Student cannot be suspended (in-school (ISS) or out-of-school (OSS)) or expelled at the time of the trip. Students assigned to alternative school will not be permitted to attend.

*Must adhere to the Dress Code set forth by Universal Orlando's Grad Bash Event Staff as well as the Hamilton County School District Dress Code as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct.

*Any student with a medical condition that requires medical attention/care during the trip must be accompanied by a Parent/Guardian/Designee as their Chaperone. The Parent/Guardian/Designee is responsible for paying for their chaperone ticket. Chaperones must be Hamilton County School Board Approved Volunteers.

*Any and all decisions/determinations pertaining to student eligibility/participation will be made at the discretion of the Grad Bash Sponsor and HCHS Principal.

Cost of Trip: 2024 Cost per student \$180 (Based on 2023 pricing. Adjustments will be made for 2024 ASAP.)

Admission to Universal Studios and Islands of Adventure Theme Parks: \$82.99

Meal Coupon: \$18.00, to be used in the park includes 1 entrée, 1 small fountain beverage, and 1 dessert.

Motor Coach Transportation: \$79.00 (based on 1 double decker bus at \$3745; divided by 50 students **ESTIMATE** OF HOW MANY STUDENTS WILL PARTICIPATE, plus \$1 Bus Driver Tip per student)

*Payment may be paid in full or in 3 installments.

1st Payment (\$60.00) Deadline: Thursday, October 19th

2nd Payment (\$60.00) Deadline: Thursday, December 7th

3rd and FINAL Payment (\$60.00) Deadline: Thursday, February 1st

*Must pay with Cash, Money Order, Card or Online.

*No refunds, whatsoever, will be made after the first payment deadline, Thursday, October 19th.

*Any overpayments will be reimbursed to students on the day of the trip in the form of cash.
