


Purpose


The Purpose of the Hagan Scholarship is to provide each recipient with the opportunity to obtain a four-year college education and **graduate debt-free**. The Workshops, Investment Accounts and Study Abroad provide recipients with a practical understanding of important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum.

Recipient Responsibilities

1. Must graduate college within four years.
2. Must achieve a 3.00 GPA each semester and maintain a 3.25 CGPA.
3. Must earn fourteen credit hours each fall semester.
4. Must earn thirty credit hours each academic year, excluding summer school.
5. Must fulfill ALL Recipient Responsibilities.

The Scholarship

The Hagan Scholarship will help pay the unmet financial need of the recipient to attend college, up to \$6,000 each semester for up to 8 consecutive semesters.

1. The disbursement amount for each semester will be determined by HSF by taking the Total Cost of Attendance for one academic year, including room and board; then deducting the total dollar amount of ALL scholarships, awards, grants, waivers and recipient's EFC; then dividing by two. Parents are not required to pay the EFC, the EFC is used only to determine the disbursement amount.
2. The award amount will be adjusted each subsequent academic year to offset the expiration or loss of other scholarships, awards, grants, waivers and changes in the recipient's EFC.
3. The scholarship is renewable for up to eight consecutive semesters if the recipient fulfills the renewal criteria and attends the second and fourth year free mandatory workshops.
4. During the fall semester of the second year of college each recipient will be provided with a **\$15,000** investment account to manage in order to learn first-hand how to invest to attain financial security.
5. During the fall semester of the third year of college each recipient achieving a 3.50 CGPA will be eligible for an all-expense paid study abroad and travel experience, worth up to **\$8,000**.
6. During the fall semester of the fourth year of college each recipient will receive **\$2,000** to fund a personal Brokerage Account.
7. There is no limit to the number of credit hours a recipient can earn during the term of their scholarship. Recipients graduating college in less than eight semesters can use the remainder of their Hagan Scholarship to attend graduate school.
8. Second and fourth-year recipients must attend a free summer workshop held prior to the start of the academic year.

FAQs

How many scholarships are awarded?

Over 2,400 scholarships have been awarded to date. Over six hundred more scholarships can be awarded in April 2022.

How much is the Hagan Scholarship worth?

1. Hagan Scholarship - Up to \$48,000
2. Study Abroad - Up to \$8,000
3. Investment Account Earnings - Up to \$10,000
4. Personal Brokerage Account - \$2,000

Is there a List of Eligible Public High Schools and a List of Eligible Colleges and Universities?

Is this a need-based or merit-based scholarship?

BOTH. Applicants must authenticate financial need in order to attend college. Scholarship recipients are selected based upon academic ability, achievement in and out of school, personal goals and future promise.

Why do you have workshops?

The mandatory workshops for second and fourth year recipients are intended to help recipients obtain a practical understanding of important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum.


Why are recipients required to work?

The Grantor worked during high school and college and believes each recipient will personally benefit by contributing to the cost of his or her education.

Why are the scholarships limited to public schools located in rural areas? The Grantor attended four small public schools located in rural counties.

Is there an application fee?

There is NO application or processing fee.

2021-2022 Scholarship Timeline

1. Application available September 1, 2021.
2. Application Deadline December 1, 2021.
3. Applications reviewed for compliance and eligibility.
4. Finalists provide supplemental information January 2022.
5. Finalist information read, evaluated and ranked.
6. Scholarships awarded April 2022.
7. All Finalists notified.

About 50% of eligible applicants are awarded scholarships, the highest award percentage of any national scholarship. If you meet the eligibility requirements you should apply for a scholarship. The award of a Hagan Scholarship has been life-changing for many recipients.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Must be a citizen of the United States.
2. Must attend an eligible public high school.
Over 6,300 eligible public high schools are listed on the HSF website.
3. Must have a 3.75 cumulative grade point average.
4. Must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university the first semester following high school graduation. Over 1,400 eligible colleges and universities are listed on the HSF website.
5. Must work 240 hours during the twelve months prior to fall semester college enrollment.
6. Must provide the FAFSA SAR showing the EFC.
Must be Pell Grant eligible.
7. Must apply for Federal and State grants, if eligible.
8. Must not have been convicted of a felony.

The Hagan Scholarship is a nationwide need-based merit scholarship designed to help rural students graduate college debt-free. Recipients must have financial need and must graduate from one of over 6,000 eligible public high schools listed on the HSF website. The scholarship provides up to \$48,000 over four years to attend college and other benefits. Hagan Scholars from 43 states are currently attending 378 colleges and universities.
